Team Registration

- Limited to 20 universities
- One team of 4 matriculated students (male, female, mixed) per university

Format

- Training Round, June 17
- Qualification Round, June 18: 18 holes, stroke play singles, three best scores off scratch from each team will be aggregated to a team score
- Finals, June 19: top 4 teams following qualification will play individual match play semi-finals, 1st vs. 4th and 2nd vs. 3rd, the winners of each semi-final will play match play foursomes for victory, the others will play for 3rd place. Teams placed 5th to 20th after the qualification will play match play singles for 5th, 7th, ..., 19th place.
Dresscode: no jeans / t-shirts on the course, neat team wear

Costs

- 150 euros per person, includes 3 nights in the youth hostel, all green fees (incl. practice round), 3 breakfasts/ 3 lunches/ 2 dinners/2 half-way snacks, party, transfers for international "fly in"-teams. drinks at one's own expense
- Non-refundable after receipt of our confirmation
- late entries from May 18, 2010 will have an extra late entry fee of 50€ per team.
