Students Matchplay 2010 Tournament Regulations

Ingolstadt, Spring 2010

Strokeplay qualification round on Friday, June 18th:

- 18 holes, singles strokeplay
- Play in three balls, players being from different universities in each group
- First tee time at 8 am, all rounds commence from the 1st tee
- The best 3 aggregate scratch scores from each team comprise the team score
- This is a handicap qualifying competition ("vorgabewirksam")
- Teams will be grouped into four qualifying groups, namely A, B, C and D at the 'Welcome Dinner' on Thursday, June 17th

Final rounds on Saturday, June 19th:

- Singles matchplay, off scratch
- Starting positions decided by the aggregated team scores after qualification with respect to the individual qualifying groups
- Team captains to nominate player order on Friday evening.
- Group winners tee off for semi finals, tee-off starts at 8 am from tee 1, play is 1st vs. 4th and 2nd vs. 3rd with respect to the team scores, matchplay singles, two players per group
- Teams placed 2nd, 3rd, 4th, and 5th in their groups will play each other. The 1st among the 2nd places teams plays against the 2nd team for the 5th place, the 3rd and 4th second teams play for the 6th place etc. Tee-off starts approximately at 9 am from Tee 1, matchplay singles, 4 players from 4 different universities per group
- The winners of the semi finals play for the Students Matchplay championship, the defeated teams play for 3rd place, tee off starts approximately at 2 pm, matchplay foursomes, two foursomes teams per group

Tournament Conditions:

The competition will be played under the rules of the German Golf Association (DGV) and with respect to the conditions and local rules of the host golf course Wittelsbacher GC Rohrenfeld-Neuburg e.V.

Play-off:

Friday / strokeplay: The rules of the DGV apply with respect to the *individual* stroke play competition. In the event of a tie, places will be decided by aggregating the scores of the qualifying round for 1) the inward halves 2) last six holes 3) last three holes 4) last two holes 5) last hole.

With respect to the matchplay *team* rankings: In case of teams having the same aggregated team score after the stroke play qualification, then the worst individual score (of the four) per team decides, the best individual score per team decides, then the worst score (of the three) per team decides.

Saturday / matchplay: In the case of any two competing semi-finalists being all square at the end of all 4 single matchplay games, one player from each team will be nominated to play in a sudden death play-off. Holes 10 then 18 will be played repetitively until a winner is established. This rule applies also for the 3rd place play-off game.

In the event of a tie after 18 holes between the finalists competing for the Students Matchplay title, we will move to a three hole matchplay playoff. Holes 10, 11 and 18 will be played and best 2 of 3 holes decides the match. Should this end in a tie, holes 10 then 18 will be played repetitively until a winner is established.
